

COVID-19 PREPAREDNESS AT KING ST. DENTAL

We're ready to see you, but we need to make sure you're ready to see us! Your safety and our safety is of utmost importance. This is a comprehensive informational sheet about the precautions we're taking and what we'll ask of you as well.

If you are a new patient, please fulfill the following requirements before your visit:

1. Fill out our patient intake forms [here](#).
2. If you have current X-ray records from within six (6) months, please have them transferred to our office.
3. Please bring a driver's licence or state ID to your appointment.
4. If you have been advised by your physician or a previous dentist to use any pre-medication because of mitral valve prolapse (MVP), heart murmur, hip or cardiac prosthesis, or if you have had rheumatic heart disease, please call your primary care physician for instructions before your appointment.

Please review this very important information relevant to COVID-19:

1. In addition to filling out the COVID-19 screening questionnaire with your other intake forms ahead of your appointment, you will be asked to fill it out again on the day of your appointment onsite.
2. Please wear a mask when you come to your appointment.
3. We will ask you to gargle either a Colgate® Peroxyl® or 3% hydrogen peroxide solution at the beginning of your appointment.
4. Due to the limited stock and inflated prices of personal protective equipment (PPE), the appointment will include a \$20.00 fee. This is critical to us sustaining our enhanced protocols to prevent the transmission of COVID-19. While the fee does not fully cover the increased cost of PPE, we will absorb the remaining bulk of the expense. This fee keeps your life and ours safe.

The PPE you will see us using include:

- Powered Air Purifying Respirator
- N95 Masks
- Hospital-Grade Full-Body Isolation Gowns
- Face Shields
- Protective Goggles
- Surgical Caps

We have made the following enhancements to our facility to fortify the prevention of cross-contamination:

- HEPA (High Efficiency Particulate Air) Cleaners – These cycle the air in our office five (5) times every hour.
- Air Purifiers (Ozone Free) – These obliterate SARS-CoV-2 at the extreme temperature of 400°F.
- Ultraviolet Light Sterilizing Equipment
